IEU initiative on minimum wages

- **Purpose**: promote fair working conditions for all workers, especially for low-wage earners.
- Minimum wages are key, but challenges exist:
 - Insufficient adequacy.
 - Some workers are not protected (coverage).
 - Insufficient involvement of social partners.
 - Lack of clear and stable national frameworks.
- The initiative will NOT set a uniform minimum wage or harmonise minimum wage settings.


European Pillar of Social Rights


